

# End of season show

At the end of the season, Patinage St-Bruno presents its *Revue Annuelle sur glace*. It is a colorful show that skaters of all levels can participate in. However, before registering your child or yourself for the show, it is important to read the following.

**The end of season show will be held during the weekend of April 19 and 20, 2025. This year, it is Easter weekend as well. 🐰**

**Members of the show committee will be present at the arena for short information sessions. Session will be held on the following dates:**

**SATURDAY, OCTOBER 19th - BETWEEN 12:00 PM AND 2:45 PM**

**SUNDAY, OCTOBER 20th - BETWEEN 9:00 AM AND 10:30 AM**

**MONDAY, OCTOBER 21st - BETWEEN 5:45 PM AND 8:00 PM**

By registering for the show, **a skater agrees to participate in all scheduled practices** unless there are valid reasons, and in this case, he must advise the director of the show of his absence – [spectacle.pstb@gmail.com](mailto:spectacle.pstb@gmail.com)

**Only one absence** per show number will be tolerated. Failure to comply with this rule may result in the skater being excluded without a refund. The goal of this policy is to help each group's preparation. There are only 5 practices to learn the choreography of an act.

The performances are prepared by professional coaches who conceive the choreography.

The show practices start on the Tuesday following spring break (March 11 2025). We invite you to consult the practice schedule BEFORE proceeding with registration. **The schedule is available on the Club's website in the section SEASON 2024-2025 – REVUE ANNUELLE SUR GLACE.**

On the weekend of the show, ALL skaters, regardless of age, **must attend all 3 performances and participate in the general practice on Friday night (April 18th 2025)**. During the general practice on Friday evening, the schedule is made so that skaters in the CanSkate groups can leave early and have a good night's sleep.

Parents may attend all practices except the general practice where only designated volunteer parents may be present.

We count on the parents' collaboration for the costume fitting sessions and the individual photo sessions in the week before the show.

The show counts many participants, with lighting and sound systems, costumes, sets, etc. For this reason, we are charging a fee to attend to each performance, whether places are for family or friends.

**Tickets will be on sale starting Saturday, March 15, 2025.** However, you **do not need** to purchase tickets to attend each of the performances your child attends. The skater is supported upon arrival at the arena by responsible volunteer parents who ensure their safety and well-being.

During performances, no contact is allowed between skaters and parents sitting in the stands. You will meet your child at the end of the show during the controlled exit of the rooms.

It should be noted that for the young participants, it is a big weekend, which can be very tiring. However, so far, the vast majority of skaters who participated in the show have enjoyed their experience!

## Registrations

The cost is \$50.00 per show number, **due at the time of registration.**  
(\$100.00 for “Waltz” number, skater + partner)

*A free number for skaters registered on  
our ice for the whole season.*

A credit in the amount of \$50.00 will automatically be added to your invoice when registering so, if the skater makes only one number, it will be free 😊.

\*\* WALTZ number - if the partner is a member of the club, register only one member. Only one member will be charged with the number’s fee. For all Waltz skaters: the partner’s name and clothing size (pants and top) must be sent via email to [spectacle.pstb@gmail.com](mailto:spectacle.pstb@gmail.com) shortly before end of registration (October 30, 2024).

### ATTENTION

**MAKE AN INVOICE PER SKATER TO BE ABLE TO GET THE \$50.00 CREDIT.** (Repeat the registration process from the beginning for each skater by clicking on the registration link on the Club’s website).

**The deadline for registration is Wednesday, October 30, 2024.** NO REGISTRATION WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THAT DATE. However, you can cancel free of charge before January 31, 2025.

Registration costs are non-refundable after January 31, 2025. They are used to cover the rental costs of costumes that are booked shortly after registration. After January 31st we will not be able to reduce the number of costumes we have booked.

When registering, you must choose the group according to the current level of the skater.

Tests passed after registration for the show and before November 30, 2024, will be validated by the test director. If a skater reaches the level required to participate in a more advanced group, they will be contacted to be offered the opportunity to change groups, at no charge.

*Exception for STAR "Waltz" (Valse)* - Skaters who pass the mandatory tests to participate in this number before November 30 will be added manually and will only have to pay the fee for this number when added.

## **Criteria to participate in each show number**

### **In which group should I register my child?**

#### **CanSkate skaters**

All Pre CanSkate or CanSkate skaters can do up to 2 numbers at the show. They can register for either the group number for their level (A, B or C) and/or the CanSkate Closure number (Fermeture Patinage Plus).

When registering, you must choose the group based on your child's current level:

- CanSkate A Group – do not have badge 2
- CanSkate B Group – have badge 2 or 3

- CanSkate C Group – have badge 4 and more
- CanSkate Adults-Teenagers-Adapted program - All skaters from Monday and Friday (adults-teenagers) classes and the skaters from the adapted program (Saturday).  
Teenagers and adults in CanSkate groups as well as the skaters from the adapted program can also register in the closure CanSkate group "Fermeture Patinage Plus".
- CanSkate – Closure (Fermeture Patinage Plus) – all CanSkate skaters.

Reminder: A badge includes 3 ribbons.



Once registration is complete, to balance the number of skaters between groups, the Director of the Annual Show can make changes in group attribution. This change is done only after the child parent's consultation.

### **Adaptive CanSkate skaters**

This year, adaptive CanSkate skaters are paired with Teenagers and Adults CanSkate group. Skaters from the adaptive CanSkate program must register in "PP Adultes/Ados".

### **Development group skaters**

To register to this show number, skaters must have participated in the development program during the whole season.

## **STAR Skaters**

Skaters must register in their completed level (Juniors-Inters-Seniors). If the skater's level changes after the show registration but before November 30, a manual group transfer will be done by the show director.

### **Prerequisites for group numbers**

#### Opening (Ouverture)

- Inters and seniors STAR skaters only.

#### Closure (Fermeture)

- All STAR skaters in private courses or group classes (STAR de groupe) (children and adults).

#### Waltz (Valse) – STAR and adults STAR skaters

- The STAR 6 dance block must be completed by November 30 to participate in this number.

#### Program Assistants (Assistants de programme)

- To participate in the Program assistant number, skaters must have completed a minimum of 6 hours of “work” on the ice during the current season.

#### STAR de groupe / Transition

- Skaters registered in STAR de groupe / Transition courses and that are not also taking private lessons.

### STAR – Juniors

- All STAR skaters in private courses or group classes who do not meet the “Inters” criteria by November 30.

### STAR – Inters

- Completed the three (3) STAR 3 blocks (dance-skills-free style) by November 30.

### STAR – Seniors

- Completed two (2) STAR 6 test blocks (skills and dances) and the complete STAR 4 Freestyle test by November 30.

### STAR – Adults

- All adult STAR skaters, who skate during the whole season at our club and who are members of our club or from another club, can participate in the “adultes STAR” number and “Fermeture STAR number”.
- Adult skaters who have completed their STAR 6 level in dance can participate in the waltz (Valse).

### **Special numbers - Registration not needed, must qualified**

#### **“Étoiles compétition STAR” special number**

- Skaters in STAR 3 level and higher that did not get a solo but are meeting the criteria to have one (have participated in at least 2 competitions with STAR 3 level or higher) can be selected in “ÉTOILES Compétition STAR” (for a maximum of 8 skaters).

### **“Étoiles compétition Adultes” special number**

- Adults STAR skaters, members of Patinage St-Bruno, who participated in at least 2 competitions during the calendar year (January to December) before the show.

### **“Voie d’accès au podium” special number**

(competitive levels)

- Must have participated all year in competition level pre-juvenile or higher.
- Must have participated in at least 5 competitions. Provincial competition counts for 2.
- Must not have participated in STAR competitions after September 1st.
- If a couple or dance skating partner can't be present for the show weekend (injury, schedule conflict, etc.), a skater could participate to the competitive number on an individual basis.
